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

•Please be advised that all of my pups sold as pet/companion must be spayed or neutered by 10 months of age. Do you acknowledge this important fact?
•Please describe any previous "dog experience," what kind of dogs you may have owned and what happened to them.
•Do you have a securely fenced yard? If no, are you willing to erect a secure fence, tie-out or kennel run for your puppy?
•Where do you plan to keep the puppy when he/she is left alone?
•Are you aware that a Malamute Puppy needs to be supervised as they grow up? (IE. A Human Puppy Sitter just like a Human child)
•Are you aware that a Malamute Puppy cannot be left alone at night? Meaning that the pup (crated or not but in a room with one of the family members) will assimilate far better into your home and family if they can always see you?
•Do you have Children? If yes, what are their ages?
•Will you complete a set of puppy training classes or do you plan to do all the training yourself?
•Do you plan on crate training your puppy (Dogs/Puppies feel safe in crates. They are den animals? If NOT, why not?

- Do you realize that having a Malamute is a lifetime commitment of 10-13 years (sometimes longer), and are you financially capable of caring for a dog for its lifetime?
- Do you have any objections to a home visit by Enchanted Dreams Alaskan Malamutes or a representative prior to the puppy arriving? (Nothing invasive. Just to meet you and your family)
- •How do you feel about keeping in touch with Enchanted Dreams Alaskan Malamutes throughout your puppy's lifetime? I am very solid on this point. These animals are family members and should be treated as such.
- •My puppies are raised on a specific food which I feel is very good and are Started on NuVet Plus Wafer Supplements (Only available through Breeders and not available in stores). I expect my new puppy owners to have the NuVet Plus Wafer Supplements and a bag of the food ready for the puppy when the pup is ready to go home (the details will be provided 2 weeks before the go home date). The transition to a new home and leaving the mom, me and the rest of the litter is very stressful for the babies regardless of how well prepared the new family is. I will ask all my new owners to buy at least one bag of the food they are on to have when they go to their new homes. This will help ease some of the stress of the transition time for the pup. After a month, I have no issues if you wish to change the diet of the puppy. But for the first month, please keep this in mind. Will you agree to keep the pup on the same diet they are used to for a month?
